

The [House Capital Budget Committee](#) considers the state capital budget which approves money for the construction and repair of public buildings and for other long-term investments, such as land acquisitions and transfers.

The capital budget also includes state money that is either given or lent to local governments or nonprofit organizations for infrastructure, housing, and cultural and heritage facilities.

The committee also considers legislation that authorizes state debt and legislation that affects state buildings and land.
