

## **FEES WHICH PASSED LEGISLATURE**

### **Tuition**

House Bill 2344 would remove the 7 percent limit in tuition increases, raising concerns about tuition hikes without limits. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.

### **Housing documentation**

House Bill 2331 would increase the fee for document recording of judgments, liens, deeds, mortgages, property ownership and real estate transactions from \$10 to \$30. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.

### **Auto dealer document**

House Bill 1939 would let dealers increase fees from \$50 to \$150 through 2014. Signed by governor 4/17.

### **Park opt-out fee on car tabs**

House Bill 2339 would change an opt-in donation for state parks on car tabs to automatically charge vehicle owners a park donation unless they specify that they don't want to donate. Passed Expected to bring in **\$23 million** to Natural Resources budget. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.

### **Court fees**

House Bill 2362 would increase court fees between \$10-30 (on top of current fees), as well as look at increasing attorney license fees. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.

### **Water discharge fees**

House Bill 1413 would authorize the Department of Ecology to charge an annual fee for domestic wastewater facility permits. Signed by governor 4/28.

### **Liquor license fees**

House Bill 2358 would increase liquor license fees for restaurants (increase \$100-200 for serving all alcohol), bars (increases about \$40), grocery stores (increases about \$15) and other places that serve beer, wine and/or spirits. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.

### **Tire replacement fee**

Senate Bill 5976 would make a temporary \$1 tire replacement fee permanent. Passed Legislature, delivered to governor.
